

## our HOUSE RULES

### General

- Registration is not necessary, you can search for an available place of your choice.
- Please park passenger cars in our parking lot.
- It is not permitted to use mats or carpets on the grass (an awning is allowed).
- The place must be kept/left neat and clean.
- Barbecuing is only permitted with appropriate equipment. Open fire is prohibited.
- There is camera surveillance on site. This is only used for safety and supervision purposes.
- The use of a Wifi extender is not permitted. Still poor reception? Tell the manager.
- When you want to leave, we ask you to put the amount due in the appropriate envelope in the letterbox. You will find this in the information house.

### Sanitary

- We appreciate it if you leave the sanitary facilities tidy after a visit, so that other guests also find themselves in a clean environment.
- Smoking is prohibited in the sanitary building.
- To prevent blockages in the sewer system, it is not permitted to flush anything other than the available toilet paper through the toilets.

### Dogs

- Dogs are welcome provided they are always on a leash and they may not cause any nuisance to other guests.
- Take them out outside the property, not in or next to the pasture, as this can make our cows very ill.
- Be alert to accidents and clean up dog poop immediately.
- Dogs are not allowed into the sanitary building, unless they are guide dogs.
- Do not leave dogs in the camper for a whole day.

### Waste

- You can dispose of your waste in the appropriate PMD and Residual Waste Containers.
- Please separate cardboard/paper from residual waste in the blue collection box next to the containers.
- Unfortunately, we can no longer collect glass, so please take your glass to the bottle bank.
- After discharging your waste water and/or chemical toilet, leave the facility clean.

### Other

- There is a first aid kit within easy reach in the information house.

- We do not accept verbal or physical violence, drugs or excessive alcohol use or noise pollution.
